

ORDINANCE NO. 21-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PURCELL, OKLAHOMA, RELATING TO CHAPTER 106 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES); ARTICLE 106-8 (STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING) DIVISION I (GENERALLY); SECTION 106-228 (PARKING TIME LIMITS MAY BE ESTABLISHED; SIGNS); ESTABLISHING TIME LIMITS FOR PARKING ON MAIN STREET BETWEEN CANADIAN STREET AND THIRD STREET, AND ON SECOND STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND THE ALLEY; DIRECTING THE PURCHASE OF SIGNS; AND PROVIDING FOR FINES AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PURCELL, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1

SECTION 106-228 SHALL READ IN ITS ENTIRETY AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

Sec 106-228 Parking Time Limits May Be Established; Signs

The City Manager, subject to any directions given by the City Council by motion or resolution may establish parking time limits or prohibit parking on designated streets or parts of streets and have appropriate signs placed on the streets. When the signs are in place, it is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in violation of such signs. By virtue of enacting this ordinance:

- A. There shall be established a two (2) hour parking time limit with respect to all parking spaces located on Main Street between Canadian Street and Third Street and on Second Street between Main Street and the alley, to be effective Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- B. The City Manager is further directed to obtain and install signs reflecting the policies set forth herein at such places as the City Manager deems appropriate.
- C. The City Manager is further directed to provide written notice to all businesses located on Main Street between Canadian Street and Third Street and on Second Street between Main Street and the alley of this new policy along with notice of the penalties associated therewith.

SECTION 2 PENALTY

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of an offense and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$1.00 for the first offense, with an additional \$1.00 for each subsequent offense up to a cap of \$20.00 and payment of all costs and fees associated therewith including any and all fees associated with impoundment of an auto.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. REPEALER


